



2012 R&D Management Conference Funding Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions relate to calls for proposals under RADMA's R&D Management Conference Funding Programme to cover: (1) the Conference fee and (2) up to £250 for travel, subsistence and accommodation for Masters and PhD students presenting a paper at the conference.

Funding is awarded across the breadth of the research and development management discipline. RADMA particularly encourages applications that explore important relevant issues or further understanding in the following areas:

1. Management of scientific and technological activity
2. Management of research development, product design and innovation
3. Strategy formulation and human resources
4. Management of technology and policy

The awards provide support to talented mid-study Masters and PhD students to attend the R&D Management Conference. Candidates must be undertaking a Masters or PhD within the research and development management discipline at a UK university. Please note that students at overseas affiliate universities are not eligible to apply to RADMA for funding.

The award covers costs related to attending the conference, specifically conference fees, travel, subsistence and accommodation.

The closing date for applications is 16 March 2012, with awards announced by 11 May 2012.

Candidates are restricted to one application each to attend the 2012 Conference. The outcome of that application does not preclude the candidate from applying for the 2013 Conference (once the call for applications for 2013 is open), nor does it affect the candidates future chances of success.

Candidates can apply before knowing if their paper has been accepted at the Conference, but should their funding application be successful they must provide evidence that their paper has been accepted before the award can be made.

If an application is successful, RADMA will forward a cheque to the candidate. Currently RADMA does not require receipts, but does require a copy of any papers presented and a brief post-conference report on the impact of the Conference upon the candidate's studies. This will contribute to RADMA's assessment of its impact in the field of R&D management.
